Support small projects to encourage creativity



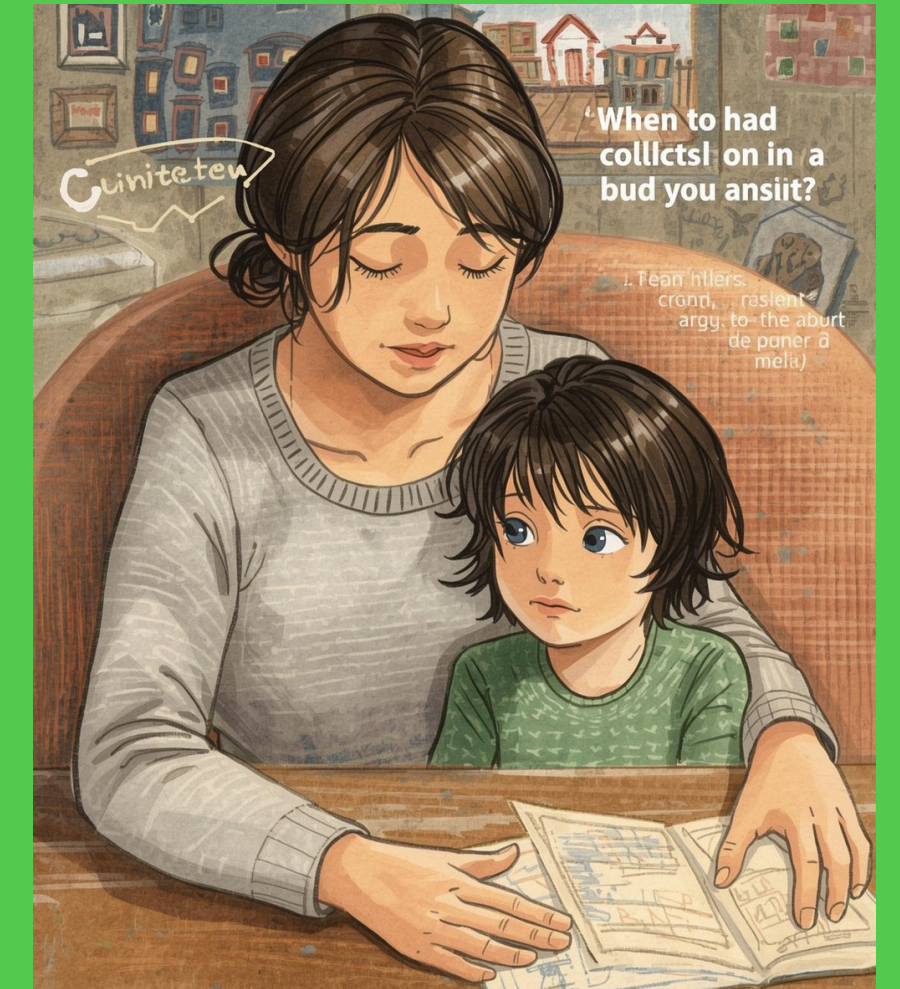
Embrace Technology
